## MISSION

Four Corners Community Farm mitigates food insecurity and builds a more inclusive community by providing the tools, resources, and network to help families, groups and volunteers grow their own food and share produce with food distribution programs.



## STRATEGY

Since 2021 we have supported community resilience and strengthened our regional foodshed by providing a farm center for residents to adopt garden parcels, produce and donate agricultural products, acquire education in food security and self-sufficiency, and congregate for community recreation and initiatives.



## HEALTH & NUTRITION

We cultivate organic vegetables with community volunteers exclusively for donation.

Residents can also adopt garden plots for personal consumption.

## COMMUNITY RESILIENCE

We offer a variety of workshops in English and Spanish focused on organic gardening and self-sufficiency. We host student groups from local schools and summer programs in immersive programming.

## SOCIAL COHESION

We create an inclusive environment with courses and materials in English and Spanish. Our grounds are open to the public daily offering a green space for recreation and programming. We run several annual community events that attract a spectrum of our region's diverse population.

## ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

We produce food using organic practices and frame our workshops with a focus on sustainability. We farm regeneratively, minimizing tillage, planting cover crops, and leaving natural habitats for pollinator species and wildlife.
